## Campground Guidelines

**Camping requests:** Requests only accepted on the official camping request form. Please forward your completed request and payment (number of nights x \$15.00) by Monday, July 7, 2008 to America's Fair, Livestock Camping Request, 5600 McKinley Parkway, Hamburg, NY 14075. Spots are reserved on a first come, first served basis.

**Arrival:** Again this year there will be adults from 4-H that will volunteer their time to help set up the campgrounds. Campers may arrive on Saturday, August 2, 2008 between the hours of 8:00am – 5:00pm and on Sunday, August 3, 2008 by appointment only. No campers will be allowed to park unless a campground committee member is present. At the time of your arrival you will be given a sticker for your allotted spot, the campground rules and a dash pass for one vehicle. It is important for all families to follow this procedure so that camp spaces are used efficiently and safely. Failure to follow this procedure may result in the loss of your camping privileges at America's Fair.

### **CAMPGROUND RULES:**

**At the direction of the New York State Department of Health and in order to maintain our operating permit, the following regulations must be implemented and adhered to at all times.**

- 1. A five (5) foot separation between each unit MUST be maintained on all sides. (This is measured from the furthest extremity, slide out or other apparatus.)**
- 2. NO awnings are allowed in the down position. This includes canvas rooms.**
- 3. NO bonfires/campfires.**
- 4. NO open flames of any type, including propane grills, charcoal, cook stoves, etc., Outside cooking is permitted in designated areas only.**
- 5. All units MUST have a fire extinguisher or method of fire protection available.**
- 6. DO NOT block the roadways with personal vehicles.**
- 7. Maintain ALL FIRE LANES at ALL times.** No cars will be parked by the campers, this will be strictly enforced. Cars parked by the campers will be towed.
- 8. Speed limit is 5 mph.**
- 9. NO gray water dumping (a scavenger service is available, contact the Park Manager in your area).**
- 10. A parent/chaperone (over 19 years of age) must be in the 4-H / FFA Livestock campgrounds from 11pm to 7am while youth are staying in the campers/tent. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** If at any time a tent/camper is found with youth (18 & younger) without a parent/chaperone (over 19 years of age), parents will be called to pick up their children and the camper/tent must leave the grounds the following day, with camping privileges revoked.
- 11. No alcohol containers allowed outside the campers.**
- 12. Quiet hours are 11pm – 7am.**

Failure to comply with regulations will result in loss of privileges and immediate removal of the unit.
