BEEF RULES

- a) All beef health records must accompany animals to the Fair.
- b) Steers and heifers must have an ear tag or a tattoo number, which is to be used as positive identification on the official beef entry form and health papers.
- c) All cattle must have been tested and had a negative result for BVD (Bovine Viral Diarrhea).
- d) Steers must weigh at least **1,000 lbs.** at time of Fair weigh-in or they will not be eligible for the show or sale. All steers will be weighed **ONE TIME ONLY and NO SUBSTITUTIONS** will be allowed.
- e) Beef tie-outs – All steers are required to be housed in the 4-H Beef Barn throughout the Fair. Heifers may be tied out in the area provided at the owner's discretion.
- f) Breeding Animals **MUST** submit a copy of the registration form with their Fair Entry.
- g) Market steers must have been administered a rabies vaccine on or before July 16, 2008 in order to adhere to the 21 days withholding period.
- h) All exhibitors must be able to lead/control entered beef animals at all times. Members who cannot control their animals may be asked to take uncontrollable animals home. This decision will be made by the Beef Advisory Committee and Extension Educator and/or FFA Advisor to ensure the safety of all exhibitors and the general public.

Awards: Blue \$14.00 Red \$12.00 White \$10.00

MARKET STEER SHOWMANSHIP

Market Steer Showmanship

All ages for showmanship are as of January 1 of the current year. All Beef breeds show together.

Awards: Blue \$8.00 Red \$6.00 White \$4.00

Class #1 – Alumni Showmanship – 20 – 21 years old

Class # 2 – Senior Showmanship – 16 – 19 years old

Class # 3 – Intermediate Showmanship – 13 – 15 years old

Class # 4 – Jr. Showmanship – 9 – 12 years old

Class # 5 – Novice Showmanship – Open to first year exhibitors, with no prior experience in showing and fitting beef cattle.

**All first place showmen must return to the show ring for Champion Market Steer Showman.*

Champion Market Steer Showman:

Previous winners of Champion Showman must compete in the age class in which they would normally compete.

Class # 7 - Master Showman:

Entries limited to previous America's Fair Market Steer Master Showmen and 2008 Champion Market Steer Showman.

BEEF BREEDING CATTLE SHOWMANSHIP

Beef Breeding Cattle Showmanship

Awards: Blue \$8.00 Red \$6.00 White \$4.00

a) Mandatory for all beef breeding cattle exhibitors.

b) Any member exhibiting a cow/calf pair may have another 4-H member lead the calf by the cow's side during this class.

c) Exhibitors must be 8 years old as of January 1, 2008

Class 14 – Alumni Breeding Cattle Showmanship – 20 – 21 years of age

Class # 15 – Sr. Beef Breeding Cattle Showmanship – 14 – 19 years of age

Class # 16 – Jr. Beef Breeding Cattle Showmanship – 8 – 13 years of age

Champion 4-H & FFA Beef Breeding Cattle Showman. Entries limited to the 1st place winners in the showmanship divisions of this category.
